## **New Child Safety Seat Inspection Station**

PHILADELPHIA Nigro Auto Body has partnered with the Kohl's Injury Prevention Program and Safe Kids Southeastern Pennsylvania Coalition at The Children's Hospital of Philadelphia to open a new child safety seat inspection station at Nigro Auto Body. Free inspections will be performed by certified Child Passenger Safety Technicians who train parents and caregivers in the proper installation and setup of their own specific child safety seats in their own vehicles. The station, located at 939-41 Washington Avenue in Philadelphia, will be open the first Tuesday of every month from 5 pm to 8 pm and will provide inspections by appointment only.

"Philadelphia families are fortunate to have a permanent site for child safety seat inspections, staffed by experts," says Domenico Nigro, Owner, Nigro Auto Body.

Motor vehicle crashes are a leading killer of children. "Under Pennsylvania law, all children under eight years of age must be restrained in an appropriate child safety seat or booster seat — whether in the family car, traveling with friends or relatives, or in a rental car or taxi," said Nigro.

According to data released by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration in early 2004, approximately 73 percent of child safety seats are used incorrectly. "It's a parent's responsibility to make sure your child's car seat is properly installed and adjusted. We're here to show you how" says Nigro.

For an appointment, call 215-985-2534. The service is free and the inspection usually takes 20 to 30 minutes per child safety seat.
